On 3/9/2018, the Municipality of Guánica submitted a proposal which consisted of four proposed activities for housing, infrastructure, economic development to be funded under CDBG-DR. The proposal expresses specifics such as an itinerary for completion, specific project locations, and express the national objective the project meets.

Community impact is summarized as follows:

- Total of 5,755 homes were affected by both hurricanes.
- Data collected from the Community Survey, and used as a tool work for the US Department of Housing, established the following:
- 58.92% of the inhabitants possess scarce resources, in other words, 19, 985 citizens possess scarce resources for rebuilding their houses.
- Most affected flood areas: Barriada Esperanza and the Community Alturas de Bélgica.
- The Community Alturas de Bélgica is an area susceptible to landslides. (Approximately 12 families reside there and have yet to be relocated because of lack of finances)

Projects proposed include the following:

Housing

- Purchase existing homes to relocate families out of high risk areas.
- Construct new homes.
- Acquire and rehabilitate homes that have been repossessed by banks.

<u>Infrastructure</u>

- Reconstruct water pumping and drainage system.
- Replace the sanitary sewer system.
- Bury electrical cables.

Economic Development

- Remodel urban center.
- Restore cultural district.
- Restore Mariano Tito Rodríguez Coliseum.
