

The first section relates to “Staffing”. To complete this section, enter the positions of personnel dedicating time to the program. Personnel listed in this section should have roles descriptions that should be specific, identifiable and can be tied directly to the services mentioned on the notice of funds. Those positions listed within this section will be required include documentation to support their respective daily time sheets and work logs for the work performed and the time invested on the related Activity.

The first column on the budget template is for you to identify the position of each employee, the next column [A] will include the quantity of employees with this title. The third column [B] must include the maximum hours per month per each employee based on a **forty (40) hour** week. The fourth column [C] must include the hourly rate (only two decimal spaces) considering salary and benefits in order to arrive at the monthly cost.

This budget template has been created with a formula already in place in column [D] (Figure 2) that will automatically calculate the maximum monthly cost per number of positions taking into account columns A, B and C. This column should not be altered as it may erase the formula, cause a miscalculation or to not function entirely.

The Professional Services section (Figure 3) is to provide details of services expected to be procured, for example legal services, technical assistance, accounting services, etc. The first column should include the name of the Services, a detailed description of the services to be procured, and on the last column the budgeted amount for the service.

The next section (**Figure 4**) of the budget detail template is to include other operating expenses, such as, supplies strictly used for technical assistance, travel, mileage, etc. These costs should be adequately labeled in the Item Name column, the description should be meticulously detailed, and the last column will include the budgeted amount for each item mentioned.

Indirect costs, if any, should be included in this section under a negotiated indirect cost rate agreement with a federal cognizant agency, a de minimis indirect cost rate (if you do not have a negotiated indirect cost rate), or an indirect cost proposal prepared in accordance with 2 C.F.R. part 200, subpart E, submitted to a federal cognizant agency, and approved by PRDOH in accordance with written policies and procedures.

The next section (**Figure 5**) of the budget detail template is to include other equipment expenses, such as, computers, machinery, projectors, etc. These costs should be adequately labeled in the Item Name column, the description should be meticulously detailed, and the last column will include the budgeted amount for each item mentioned. This information must also be included in the Contract Budget Template.

After all these sections are filled, you can proceed to fill the Contract Budget Template tab (Figure 7) which is a summary of all the information previously mentioned and should have been entered and completed in the Budget Detail tab.

It should be taken into consideration, that costs must meet the following criteria in order to be allowable under federal laws (2 C.F.R. Part 200.400):

- Be necessary and reasonable for the performance of the Federal award and be allocable thereto under these principles.
- Conform to any limitations or exclusions set forth in these principles or in the Federal award as to types or amount of cost items.
- Be consistent with policies and procedures that apply uniformly to both federally-financed and other activities of the non-Federal entity.
- Be accorded consistent treatment. A cost may not be assigned to a Federal award as a direct cost if any other cost incurred for the same purpose in like circumstances has been allocated to the Federal award as an indirect cost.
- Be determined in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP), except, for state and local governments.
- Not be included as a cost or used to meet cost sharing or matching requirements of any other federally-financed program in either the current or a prior period.
- Be adequately documented.

The purpose of this Budget Template is to facilitate the budget details to subrecipients. The Cost Type section (**Figure 8**) is to identify the type of cost, for instance, outreach activities, traveling cost, staffing, etc. The column labeled Chart of Accounts Code is to identify PRDOH’s budget category code (you may leave this blank, if needed these codes can be updated during the contracting process). The Activity description section is a way to provide additional details to further identify the cost type. For instance, if your cost type is “travel” then the activity detail can say “Travel associated with conducting community work sessions for engaging potential workforce training participants”.

Based on the funding that you received in your contract with PRDOH, you will enter the cost type for your subcontractor. For instance, if you received funds for planning activities then your subcontractor budget will look like the following image.
